**Thomas's professional experience:** Training instructor, public obedience instructor, handler, police dog training assistant, agitator and veterinary assistant.

### **Schutzhund**

- 1981 - 1984 Thomas competed with female German Shepherd Dog- "Cita vom Dorneburger Bach" in over a dozen Schutzhund 3 trials.
- 1982 Thomas finished 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall with "Cita" at the United Schutzhund Clubs of America National Schutzhund 3 Championship. He received the highest score in the protection phase, highest scoring female dog, and youngest handler ever at the U.S.A. Nationals to that date.
- 1983 Thomas finished 2<sup>nd</sup> with "Cita" at the Rocky Mountain Regional Schutzhund 3 Championship.
- 1987 – Present Thomas trained and titled over 30 German Shepherd Dogs and Rottweilers to various Schutzhund degrees  
Thomas is the training director of the Sunland Schutzhund Club. He directed the training of more than 50 handlers and their dogs, of which many handler/dog teams have continued to compete successfully at regional and national events.
- 1991 Thomas was the trial chairperson and organizer of the ARC – American Rottweiler Club National Schutzhund Championship.
- 1993 Thomas trained and titled "Zigo von Bewie" to Schutzhund 2 and KKL1. "Zigo" went on to place VA3 in the working class males at the National Sieger Show.  
Thomas organized the United Schutzhund Clubs of America Southwest Regional Schutzhund Championship.

### **Police K-9**

- 1982 – Present Thomas has served as an agitator and acting trainer for police departments in various regions of the United States including: Bakersfield CA, Beverly Hills CA, Odessa TX, and Greenwood Village CO.
- 1988 – Present Thomas instructed the training for several Beverly Hills Police Department K-9 handler units in a basic course for street patrol.
- 1984 Thomas served as the translator for Karl Fabritz, renowned West German Police dog trainer. He translated from German to English

a course in narcotics and explosive detection, which lasted 8 weeks.

### **Agitation**

- 1981 – Present Thomas agitated in over 50 Schutzhund trials and also in many German Shepherd Dog Breed Surveys and Rottweiler Breed Suitability Tests.
- 1983 Thomas was the agitator for Greenwood Village Police Department K-9 units. He agitated for the United States Police K-9 Association Rocky Mountain Regional Championship in Denver Colorado.
- 1988 – 1991 Thomas served as chief agitator at the qualification trial for the selection of the U.S. team to go to the German Shepherd Dog World Championship.
- 1989 Thomas was the agitator for the United Schutzhund Clubs of America Southwest Regional Schutzhund Championship in Tucson, Arizona
- 1991 Thomas was the agitator for the Bakersfield Police Department K-9 trials in which there were over 50/handler/dog teams competing.
- 1992 Thomas was the agitator for the United Schutzhund Clubs of America Southwest Regional Schutzhund Championship in Riverside, California.

### **Service Dogs**

- 1992 Thomas trained a Rottweiler named “Bruno” for a paraplegic confined to a wheelchair, for independence of everyday life. “Bruno” was trained in compliance with the American Disabilities Act for service dogs for independence.

- 1984 – Present Thomas personally obedience trained over 350 dogs of all breeds.
- 1988 – Present Thomas instructed obedience classes for more than 1800 people and their dogs.
